

How is FACE Time different for 11th and 12th graders?

Upperclassmen are not assigned to a daily location, but are expected to use this time to take care of academic business. Seek teachers as needed, meet with group members, finish a lab, review for a quiz or test, visit a college or military recruiter, ask a staff member for a recommendation, or see a counselor for post secondary planning.

The Library, Library Annex and cafeterias are available for quiet study.

REMEMBER, you must report to FACE Time when a teacher gives you an appointment card.

More about FACE Time:

What if more than one teacher asks me to report for FACE Time on the same day?

Show your teacher an appointment card and schedule the conflicting FACE Time appointment on another day.

Yes, if you provide your own. The snack bar will be closed during FACE Time. Cafeterias are study areas.

May I shoot hoops? The gymnasium is reserved for PE make up. It will not be available for open gym.

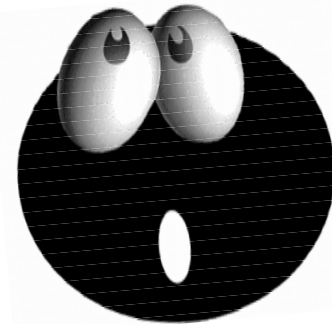

When is it and where do I go?

Freshmen return to SLAM locations for FACE Time on Wednesday, Thursday and Friday.

Sophomores report to Advisory locations for FACE Time on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday.

At the beginning of the year, juniors and seniors report to Mentor locations. Later, upperclassmen will manage FACE Time on their own.

How does it work?

For 25 minutes each day, teachers will be in FACE Time locations, available and ready to assist students who need extra time, attention and help.

Teachers will issue appointment cards to students in need of an aca-

ademic boost. Students must attend if given a card.

Students may also decide when they need to see a teacher. Simply ask the teacher for an appointment card.

9th and 10th graders must have a card to leave FACE Time locations to see a teacher. Otherwise, they will remain in locations for quiet study. Students are expected to work on academics, so arrive with school work!

What's FACE Time?
